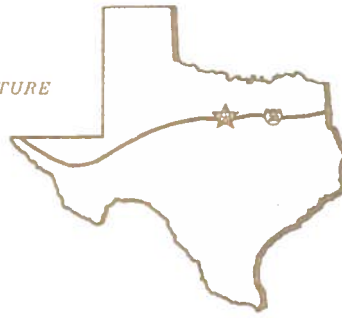

## DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, the CITY OF CISCO on the 30th of MAY, 2016, has suffered widespread or severe damage or loss of property impacting numerous homes and dozens of families (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from SEVERE RAIN STORMS FOLLOWED BY FLOODING OF THE ROAD AND BRIDGE SYSTEM ALONG WITH SIGNIFICANT FLOODING TO HOMES AND BUSINESSES AROUND LAKE CISCO and;

WHEREAS, the MAYOR of the CITY OF CISCO has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CISCO:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for CISCO, TEXAS pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF CISCO.

Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the CITY SECRETARY.

Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the CITY emergency management plan.

That his proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
